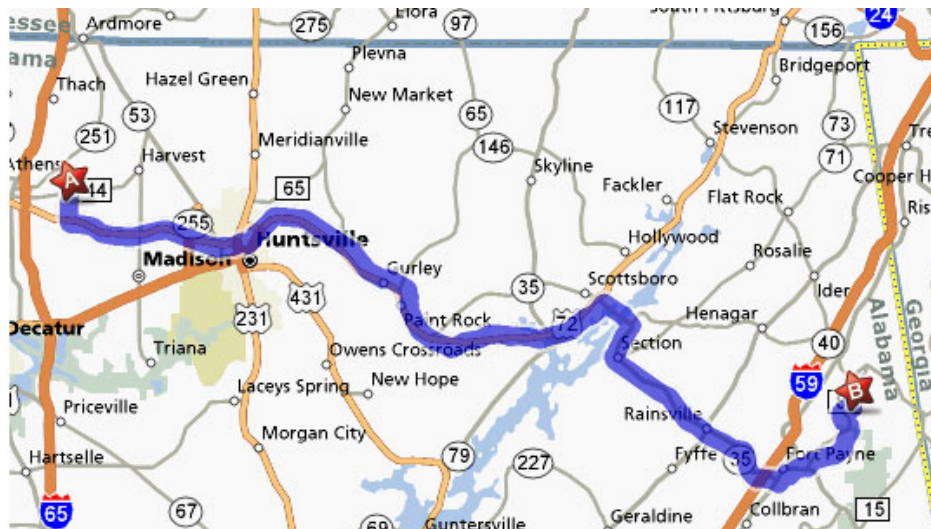


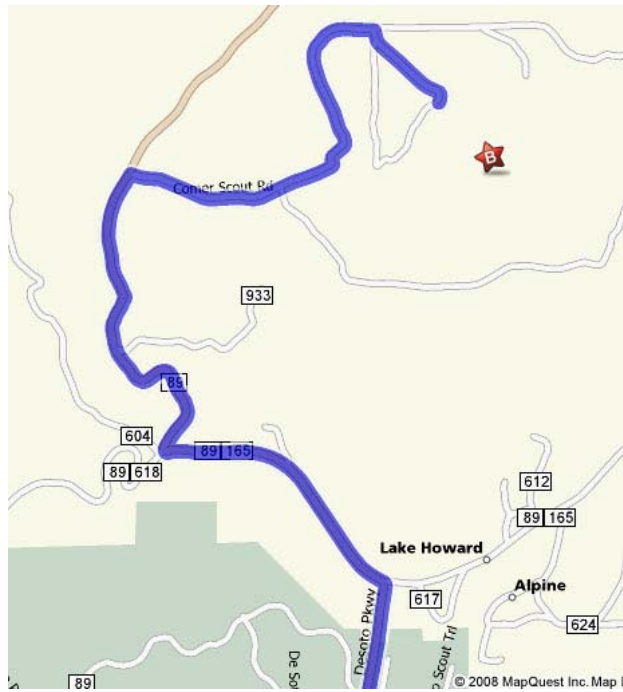
## Directions to

## Camp Comer

Mentone, AL

- Take I-565 to Hwy 72 East to Scottsboro. You may want to consider a stop at the McDonalds in Scottsboro for a bathroom break, as there are not many places to stop after that until you get to Comer.
- Continue on Hwy 72 East until Hwy 35 (Veteran's Drive). Turn right, going South on Hwy 35.
- Cross the Tennessee River bridge and then turn left onto Hwy 40 (headed East).
- Continue on Hwy 40 (23.5 mi). You will cross Interstate 59 and then dead-end into US 11. Turn right onto US 11.
- Go approximately 100-200 feet and then turn left onto AL Hwy 117 (South).
- Continue on Hwy 117 until you are going up the mountain and then you will make a sharp right turn onto TUTWILER GAP ROAD. Look for a blue sign that says "Cloudmont". \*\*\*\***This will almost be a U-turn to the right**\*\*\*\*
- Continue up TUTWILER GAP ROAD until it stops at the top of the Hill.
- Merge right and follow along this road until you see the Camp Comer ARCH on the Left.
- Once you get on the camp road, watch for pot holes and speed bumps.
- Once parked, register at the mess hall. They should provide Camp Location and meal tickets at registration.





Things to pack:

- Change of clothes (you be the judge depending on temperatures).  
It does get cool as you are on the top of Mountain (ok a big Hill). Layers are always a great idea.
- Change of shoes could be a good idea if it rains and gets muddy.
- Snacks if you want
- Pillow
- Lantern
- Flashlights
- Walking shoes
- Coffee mug if you want
- Rain poncho
- Any special needs you might have.

**No pets are allowed at Camp Comer.**
